TAKE STEPS TO KEEP YOUR COMPANY AND WORKERS SAFE.



KNOW THE SYMPTOMS

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath and breathing difficulties
- Symptoms can appear 2 to 14 days after exposure



YOUR POLICIES

- Review your Business Continuity and Crisis Communication Plan
- Encourage workers to stay home when sick
- Allow work from home arrangements if possible



STOP THE SPREAD

- Routinely clean all work environments
 - Provide hand sanitizer, soap, water, tissues and touch-free disposal receptacles
- Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer



DIAGNOSED EMPLOYEES

- Follow CDC guidelines for coronavirus risk assessment: <u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/php/risk-assessment.html</u>
- Separate sick employees from other workers and send them home
- Notify employees of possible COVID-19 exposure at work
- Maintain the sick worker's confidentiality, as required by the ADA
